Amarillo Economic Analysis

Amarillo's economy feels like it is a little better, with higher retail sales, strong construction, more people working and good agriculture activity.

Retail sales were up 8% from 12 months ago. Year to Date Sales are flat with 2023. New Car Sales are 7% higher than a year ago. Used Car Sales are up nearly 12%.

Airline Boardings are up 2% from a year ago, and the Hotel/Motel Tax Collections are up 6%. The Household Survey shows almost 1,900 more people working than a year ago. The Employer's Survey is up 1,500. Wages are up 5% from this time last year.

Housing is doing better than last year. 30-Year Mortgage Rates are hovering round 7%, but there were 11 more Housing Starts last month compared to 12 months ago. Year to Date Starts are down 6% - 15 units-from a year ago.

Construction is up 90% from 12 months ago. A \$20 million new Surgery Center bolsters this month's Building Permits. Year to Date Construction is more than triple the first 6 months of 2023.

There remain 4 drilling rigs in the Panhandle, as gas prices remain low. Natural Gas is at \$2.92, up from \$2.34 last year. Oil is \$77, up 12% from a year ago.

Fat Cattle have been selling at all time highs. This is good for the current market, but in the next year, cattle on feed might be operating at a loss. Dairies have hopefully turned the corner. Milk prices are up 19% from a year ago to \$20. Hopefully area dairies will see profits after a long spell of losses and break evens.

For those who got wheat in, we should get a good crop this year. Cutting has started and prices are flat, with a year ago. Corn is planted, but prices are down 25% from a year ago. We hear that cotton is off to its best start in a year and prices are up 6%.





Hotel/Motel Receipt Tax (In Thousands)




Residential Housing Starts




Building Permits


(Residential/Commercial - Millions of Dollars)




Interest Rates (30 Year Mortgage Rates)




Percent Unemployment (State Adjusted Numbers)








Corn (Price Per Bushel)
